The highlight has to be the Turkey Vulture, since it was the only zero probability bird we saw. We did miss some highly probable birds, the Band-tailed Pigeon (100%) and Dark-eyed Junco (88%), to name a couple.

We welcomed back Mickey Areeda from Michigan. She plans to be around until end of February. I can add that we had beautiful weather for the walk so all in all, once again, not half-bad.
