We observed 24 species, 1.7 above the prediction of 22.3. Two big disappointments: no Band-tailed Pigeon and no California Towhee. They were both 88% probable. But, we had two zero probable birds to make up for it. The record for the week is 29 and with the two I mentioned and a kinglet, Cooper's Hawk, and a different warbler we would have tied the record. So, it was a good walk, despite breezy conditions.
