We had a fine walk. We observed 24 species, 0.3 species more than predicted, and 2 above the median for the week. The yellow-rumps are just about gone; only saw 3 and next week the probability is 0.25 and then zero until week 38 when it is 0.12. It gets to a probability of 1 by week 42. The Cooper's are on the nest on Arden. We saw 3 today. No Mallard, even though the probability was high at 0.88. We saw a beautiful Wilson's Warbler in the maintenance yard, up close and personal, and down low so we could easily see the black cap. And the starlings may be nesting in a hole in a tree on Wilson. Saw them near the hole two weeks in a row now. Nice walk.
