Viveca got a good look at a Black-headed Grosbeak, so that was the highlight bird of the day. Coming in a close second was a Red-breasted Nuthatch, which Chris put us on to. We did see a Yellow-rumped Warbler, which had a probability of 25%. Next week, the probability is zero so any reporting of one will have to be by eye and not by ear. Overall the walk was slightly above expected, with 24 species observed vs 23.3 predicted.
