We'll keep an eye on that. We did not see a Yellow-rumped Warbler, which keeps the story going about how they appear in week 40 and depart in week 16, plus or minus a week. So, that was good. Overall, we only got 20 species, which was one above the median but 2.8 below the prediction. Nonetheless, a very pleasant walk.
