We observed 22 species and the prediction was for 22.1, so not half bad. I asked Chip early on to look for a feather on the ground to get us that 1/10 bird, and he looked, but he did not find one. Otherwise, we would have hit the prediction exactly. The highest-probability bird we missed was the Mallard at 71%, followed by the Western Bluebird, Band-tailed Pigeon, and White-throated Swift, all at 57% each. The Wilson's and Yellow Warblers continue in the trees just to the East of the turtle ponds.
