The swifts and swallows are around, so that is good. And we did see both a Red-shouldered Hawk and a Cooper's Hawk, so that was good. Ok, so it started slow, but it wasn't a bad walk in the end. In fact, we were only 4 short of the maximum for the week. Pleasant weather too.
