But we missed observing some pretty common birds: Lesser Goldfinch, House Finch, Northern Mockingbird, Black Phoebe, and California Towhee, to name a few. On the positive side, we did see 2 Cooper's Hawks and 1 Red-tailed Hawk, both of which were zero-probability birds. Looking forward to cooler weather next week.
