It cooled off and the walk was pleasant. Our 15 species matched the median for the week so we did OK. We missed some highly-probable birds, such as Western Bluebird (88%), American Crow (88%), and House Finch (100%), but we did get a zero-probable one, the Yellow Warbler. Next week is week 38 and the Yellow-rumped Warblers should start to arrive over the next two or three weeks. Be on the lookout if you are in the Pasadena area. Other warblers often arrive even sooner, and today's walk bore that out with a sighting of a Yellow Warbler.
