Even my iBird Plus app had no recordings of the Yellow-headed Parrots. I could make some and send them in as they are often in my neighborhood. They have a very unique kind of call. But, of course, I won't do that. Next week is week 40 and you know what that is? It's Yellow-rumped Warbler week. We'll see how reliable they are. My money's on them.
