We were surprised to see 2 California Scrub-Jays, but then I noticed they were 62% probable, so I guess it's our memory that's off. Next week it's Yellow-rumped Warbler time. Almost a guarantee – it's 75% probable. We need to see the first one of the season and the last one, but in between, we can list them if we hear them. That's my Yellow-rumped Warbler rule. The season runs from week 40 to week 16 of next year.
