We did very well; we got 22 species when the prediction was 19.1. We are starting to see the warblers. We didn't get the yellow-rumped, which was only 25% probable, but it is 75% probable for the next walk. The main highlight was the observation of 4 Cedar Waxwings over on Del Mar. Those were only 12% probable. They were acting like flycatchers; I've not seen them do that before. Interesting walk.
