So, we did get a Yellow-rumped Warbler, but only one. Next week they should be here in full force, not to leave again until week 16 of next year. We got 17 species, which was below the prediction of 19.7, and even below the median, which was 18. But, we did have an outstanding bird, a Western Tanager in Tournament Park. And we got a zero-probability bird – White-throated Swift, six of them. We did get an Orange-crowned Warbler and we'll be looking to get some diversity in the warblers in the coming weeks.
