We observed 21 species, 1.4 above the prediction, so that was good. Ruby-crowned Kinglets were plentiful (4), but we got shout out on the Black Phoebe, which was a 100% probable bird. We debated a lot on a distant possible Kingbird, but ultimately decided not to even call it Kingbird, sp., even though I do have that category. There seemed to be a marking on the wing that didn't fit a Kingbird. Overall, a good walk.
