Best bird was a Nuttall's Woodpecker, which was our bird with the lowest probability of observation at 14%. We missed seeing a Common Raven, which had a 100% probability of observation. At least that was only 100 percent we missed. We were baffled as the weather could not have been better. We hope to rebound next week.
