Highlight birds were the Say's Phoebe out on the lawn in front of Beckman Institute, a Black-throated Gray Warbler in the same tree as last week on the Prufrock property, and a Red-shouldered Hawk sitting in full view on Arden Rd. Also, we saw American Goldfinch for the first time in a long time. Those were in Tournament Park. It was a very good walk indeed.
