A question was answered today by Wan-Ying. She found that the record number of zero percent probability birds on a walk was 6, set on 6/27/2023. It turns out my report for that day is wrong. It states there were 5 zero percenters, but 6 were listed. My bad. She also reports that 5 zero percenters were reached 3 times, on 9/14/2021, 6/7/2022, and 2/5/2025. Thanks, Wan-Ying for digging out this information. Today we had only one in that category, the White-breasted Nuthatch. That's a good one to get. Pleasant day, nice walk.
