We had an interesting walk, observing five zero probability birds, including a Mountain Chickadee, the last two sightings of which were one time each in 2025 and 2021, so reasonably unusual. The Oak Titmouse, White-breasted Nuthatch, Hooded Oriole and Cassin's Kingbird were the other four. So, good diversity. We observed 23 species, 4.6 above the prediction. Good walk.
